<u>EU-GB Phased Import Regime: EU goods requiring a PC and pre-notification from 01 April 2021</u>

Plant health controls on EU regulated plants and products are being introduced in stages from 01 January 2021, to help business adapt as the transition period ends.

This guide provides guidance on the EU plants, plant produce and other regulated objects which will require a phytosanitary certificate and pre-notification for import to GB from 01 April 2021.

From 01 April 2021, the phytosanitary certificate requirements for EU regulated plants and products will fall into two categories:

- 'Regulated and Notifiable' material you can only bring into GB with a phytosanitary certificate and must be notified in advance of landing
- 'Regulated' material you can only bring into GB with a phytosanitary certificate but does not require advanced notification of landing

This guide is divided into different commodity groups:

- General
- Parts of plants, other than fruits and seed. This includes cut flowers, parts of plants for decoration or culinary purposes, and vegetables.
- Fruits
- Seeds for planting
- Isolated bark
- Wood

For details of the phytosanitary certification requirements, please refer to Schedule 10 of The Plant Health (Phytosanitary Conditions) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020.

A full definition of 'plants', 'plant products' and 'plants for planting' can be found in Article 2 of the <u>Plant Health Regulation 2016/2031</u>.
